Preface

Chapter 1

The reason I say all the non-Jewish people is because all Jews go to hell according to Christians. Or, is Hitler in heaven because he was actually doing God's work, and killing the Jews was exactly what God wanted Hitler to do? That would make Heaven the perfect place for Hitler because there aren't any Jews in Heaven.

Future generations should remember that Adolph Hitler could not have come into power without the support of the Protestant and Catholic churches and the Christian German populace. "My feeling as a Christian points me to my Lord and Savior as a fighter. It points me to the man who once in loneliness, surrounded by a few followers, recognized these Jews for what they were and summoned men to fight against them and who, God's truth was greatest not as a sufferer but as a fighter. In boundless love as a Christian and as a man I read through the passage which tells us how the Lord at last rose in His might and seized the scourge to drive out of the Temple the brood of vipers and adders. To-day, after two thousand years, with deepest emotion I recognize more profoundly than ever before the fact that it was for this that He (Jesus) had to shed His blood upon the Cross. As a Christian I have no duty to allow

myself to be cheated, but I have the duty to be a fighter for truth and justice. And if there is anything which could demonstrate that we are acting rightly it is the distress that daily grows. For as a Christian I have also a duty to my own people.” -Adolf Hitler, in a speech on 12 April 1922 (Norman H. Baynes, ed. *The Speeches of Adolf Hitler, April 1922-August 1939*, Vol. 1 of 2, pp. 19-20, Oxford University Press, 1942) This is something that Hitler said in one of his speeches, it sounds an awful lot like the ramblings of today’s priests and pastors.

Was Hitler a bad guy? Not according to millions of people who had and have the same beliefs as him. What did Hitler do that the Crusaders didn’t do? Hitler killed people that weren’t Christians. Christians today look at the Crusaders like they were saviors for the Christian religion. All they did was kill other humans that didn’t believe in the Christian religion. Some people would say “Hitler’s not in heaven because he didn’t repent for his sins” first of all, it doesn’t say you have to repent to get to heaven. Secondly, Hitler didn’t have to repent, because he was doing God’s will by ridding the Earth of the Jews. Some would say “Hitler killed people so he can’t be in heaven.” Nowhere does it say that you won’t go to heaven if you kill someone. Also, what about the millions and millions of Christians that have killed in the past? They all believed in God and believed that Jesus was the son of God. According to the Bible, they’re in Heaven. So

who do we have in heaven? Murderers, rapists, serial killers, pedophile priests, and Hitler, all go to heaven as long as they are Christians, that doesn't sound like a place I want to spend eternity. Why would anyone want to go to heaven if they had to be around a bunch of Nazi's and even Hitler himself?

When I was a child I went to Central Lutheran Christian Day School in Tacoma Washington for 3 years, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade. The first thing I learned was, if you don't believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God, then you will go to hell, period, end of discussion! The second thing I learned was not to judge people. The third thing I learned was to judge people. If I met someone that wasn't Christian, a Jewish person for example, I would automatically know they were going to hell because they didn't believe that Jesus was the son of God. Therefore, I would automatically judge them. I was taught that the rock band Kiss and others were devil worshipers. I was also told I wasn't allowed use Crest toothpaste because of the half moon and stars on the container. Does that sound like something we should be teaching people, let alone children? I'm judging Hitler on the fact that he was the direct cause of 50 million deaths, which is exactly how we should judge people. Actions speak louder than

words, and according to Hitler's actions, in my opinion, he should burn in Hell for all eternity, if there was a Hell.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16). Chapter 2

Martin Luther and Henry The 8th

In 1525 King Henry the 8th wanted to be with Anne Boleyn instead of Catherine of Aragon his, then wife and Queen of England. At that time England was a Catholic nation and basically did what the Catholic Church said. The church would not grant King Henry his divorce so he needed to figure out a way to get divorced. Anne Boleyn (or someone close to him) gave the writings of Martin Luther to King Henry which stated that the King answered to God and God alone. So King Henry found a way to get divorced from the queen and be with Anne Boleyn. Anne Boleyn gave the writings of Martin Luther (Protestantism) to King Henry so he would change his views on the Catholic Church and be able to divorce his wife at that time, Queen Catherine. King Arthur broke away from the Catholic Church

and made the nation a Protestant Nation. The split from the Catholic Church made the English monarch head of the English church by "Royal Supremacy", thereby establishing the Church of England. In 1536 he had Anne's head chopped off.

6 years after King Henry the 8th died, his daughter (who he had with his first wife Catherine of Aragon) "Bloody Mary" became queen. They called her that because she had almost 300 Protestants burned alive in the 5 years she was queen. This is what religious people do; kill those who don't believe what they believe. Protestants, knowing their lives were in great danger, fled England and went to America. By doing so, they created the capitalist economy we have today. Think for a second how profound that is. America became a capitalist nation because King Henry wanted to have sex with Anne Boleyn. I know that sounds crazy, but that is what it boils down to.

America is built on a sin. Only the Amish live the way the bible says to live. Capitalism by definition is a sin. One of the 10 commandments says *"You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor"* The definition of covet is, to wish for, esp. eagerly: *He won the prize they all coveted.* The USA is built on the fact that every single day we covet what belongs to our neighbors. Every store in the nation has items that belong to other people and

every day we covet those items and buy them. Our countries economy was created because King Henry the 8th read the teachings of Martin Luther, the Jews were slaughtered because of his writings, WWII was a direct cause of Martin Luther, the atom bomb was created because of Martin Luther, Martin Luther King Jr. was named after Martin Luther, and if that isn't ironic, I don't know what is. Stop and think of the profound affect that this one man has had on this world, it's staggering.

Who is worse, the people that flew the jets into the World Trade Centers and the Pentagon, or Osama Bin Laden? I asked a few people that question and every one said Osama Bin Laden. If you ask any Christian in the world if they thought that Martin Luther was in heaven, they would all say "Yes, of course, he's the father of the Lutheran Religion". If you asked the same people if they thought that Hitler was in heaven, they would all say "No, he slaughtered millions of people". Here is the problem with that; Martin Luther is the person who inspired Hitler to kill the Jews, and all the other millions that died because of WWII. Think of Martin Luther as Hitler's teacher. Who is worse, the person that pulled the trigger or the person that convinced the person to pull the trigger? Again, same answer as before, the mastermind behind the crime is far worse than the person who committed the crime. Keep in mind that Hitler didn't actually go to the concentration camps and kill all the Jews, he

told people to do it. Martin Luther inspired Hitler, Hitler inspired others, and because of their inspiration the world got the Holocaust and WWII. In every city in America you will find a Lutheran Church and throughout history there has been no one who has been more responsible for so many deaths than Martin Luther. His hate and anger for the Jews spawned Hitler's hate and anger for the Jews which caused 50 million deaths in WWII.

Most all Lutherans today would say, "We don't preach hate, they may have in the 1500's but we don't do that now." That may be true, so why would Protestants want to associate themselves with a person that caused millions of deaths through his hate for Jews. That's like creating a church named after Hitler, most people would think that is crazy, but it's no different having your church named after Martin Luther. For thousands of years religion has been pure evil! They teach people to judge other people and create barriers between human beings based solely on their different beliefs. It very sad that people all over the world let religion manipulate us into thinking people are bad because they are Buddhist, Jewish, Atheist, Mormon, or Scientologists for that matter. People should be judged by their actions more than their beliefs.

Luther wrote that the Jews are a "base, whoring people, that is, no people of God, and their boast of

lineage, circumcision, and law must be accounted as filth." They are full of the "devil's feces ... which they wallow in like swine," and the synagogue is an "incorrigible whore and an evil slut ..." He argues that their synagogues and schools be set on fire, their prayer books destroyed, rabbis forbidden to preach, homes razed, and property and money confiscated. They should be shown no mercy or kindness, afforded no legal protection, and these "poisonous envenomed worms" should be drafted into forced labor or expelled for all time. He also seems to advocate their murder, writing "we are at fault in not slaying them."

Since WWII the majority scholarly view is that Luther's treatise (*On the Jews and Their Lies*) has been a major influence on Germany's attitude toward its Jewish citizens in the centuries between the Reformation and the Holocaust. Four hundred years after it was written, Julius Streicher, editor of the Nazi newspaper *Der Stürmer*, described it as the most radically anti-Semitic tract ever published.

According to Wikipedia about Luther, salvation was attainable only by true repentance and faith in Jesus as the Messiah, a faith unmediated by the church. These ideas inspired the Protestant Reformation and changed the course of Western civilization. Luther's refusal to submit to the authority of Charles V resulted in his being declared an outlaw of the state as he had been excommunicated from the Roman Catholic

Church. Because of the perceived unity of the medieval Roman Catholic Church with the secular rulers of Western Europe, the widespread acceptance of Luther's doctrines and popular vindication of his thinking on individual liberties were both phenomenal and unprecedented.

Much scholarly debate has concentrated on Luther's writings about the Jews. His statements that Jews' homes should be destroyed, their synagogues burned, money confiscated and liberty curtailed were revived and used in propaganda by the Nazis in 1933–45. As a result of this and his revolutionary theological views, his legacy remains controversial.

The radical side of Luther's propaganda came through when he began to criticize the Catholic Church with the 95 Theses which was posted in 1517 at the start of the Protestant Reformation. His attacks continued as he criticized the Catholic Church of clerical fraud and papal tyranny and in the 2nd of a series of treatises published in 1520 *On the Babylonian Captivity of the Church* for the first time publicly announced that the Pope was the Anti-Christ. This idea that the Pope was the Anti-Christ had fed into Reformation propaganda; pamphlets had detailed a popular legend that Elias and Enoch were two prophets sent by God to reveal the anti-Christ and that Martin Luther was the angel of the apocalypse sent to fight the Pope.

The Protestants came to America on the mayflower and they were a large part of the first settlers in America. They had to leave England because when the king of England died, his sister took over and persecuted anyone that wasn't catholic, so they got on the mayflower and went to America.

Luther advocated an eight-point plan to get rid of the Jews either by religious conversion or by expulsion:

"First to set fire to their synagogues or schools and to bury and cover with dirt whatever will not burn, so that no man will ever again see a stone or cinder of them."

"Second, I advise that their houses also be razed and destroyed."

"Third, I advise that all their prayer books and Talmudic writings, in which such idolatry, lies, cursing and blasphemy are taught, be taken from them."

"Fourth, I advise that their rabbis be forbidden to teach henceforth on pain of loss of life and limb. ..."

"Fifth, I advise that safe-conduct on the highways be abolished completely for the Jews."

"Sixth, I advise that usury be prohibited to them, and that all cash and treasure of silver and gold be

taken from them. Such money should now be used in ... the following way... Whenever a Jew is sincerely converted, he should be handed a certain amount..."

"Seventh, I commend putting a flail, an ax, a hoe, a spade, a distaff, or a spindle into the hands of young, strong Jews and Jewesses and letting them earn their bread in the sweat of their brow... For it is not fitting that they should let us accursed Goyim toil in the sweat of our faces while they, the holy people, idle away their time behind the stove, feasting and farting, and on top of all, boasting blasphemously of their lordship over the Christians by means of our sweat. No, one should toss out these lazy rogues by the seat of their pants."

"Eighth, if we wish to wash our hands of the Jews' blasphemy and not share in their guilt, we have to part company with them. They must be driven from our country" and "we must drive them out like mad dogs."

Now if that isn't preaching hate, I don't know what is. My wife is Lutheran, she believes in God, thinks that Jesus is the son of God, and thinks that creation is how man was created. She is my best friend and I love her more than anyone on Earth, and will continue to do so even though we have different beliefs. It was shocking to me that she knew nothing

about Luther and his hate for the Jews. That didn't change anything, she is still a Christian.

Another interesting fact is that Martin Luther King, Jr. was initially named Michael King, Jr. until 1935, when his father changed both of their names to Martin to honor the German Protestant Martin Luther. Martin Luther King Jr. was named after a man that thought the Jews should be wiped off the face of the Earth. This happened at the exact same time the Nazis were reading Martin Luther's literature and planning the genocide of the Jews and the takeover of the world. Yet Martin Luther King Jr. fought his whole life against everything Martin Luther and the Nazis stood for.

Chapter 3

Who or what is a Christian?

If Hitler was a Christian, what is a Christian? My generic version of a Christian is someone who believes in God and believes that Jesus Christ was the son of God. The Wikipedia definition of "Christian" is different among Christian groups. Roman Catholics, Eastern Orthodox, and many Protestants define a Christian as one who has become a member of the Church through the sacrament of baptism. In these churches, infants who are baptized may be considered Christians, although they are expected to make a personal affirmation of faith when old enough to think on their own.

Evangelical and fundamentalist denominations do not practice infant baptism and do not believe that baptism is connected with salvation. Rather, they

consider it to be a public voluntary act of identifying oneself with Jesus Christ. They encourage youth and adults to "become Christians" by personally "accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior," and to follow that decision with Believer's Baptism. These groups also use the phrase "born-again" to describe becoming a Christian.

Here's something that I don't understand: White supremacists pride themselves on being good, white Christians, but what they don't realize is that Christianity is another form of Judaism. The Old Testament is part of the Jewish Bible. Jesus Christ was Jewish, and the Bible says that every human on Earth came from the eight family members of Noah's Jewish family! Christianity and the New Testament were put together from a group of Catholics, and the last time I checked, white supremacists weren't too fond of Catholics either. I think they need to rethink the thought of calling themselves Christians.

A few denominations and sects teach that baptism is necessary for salvation - the transition from non-Christian to Christian. They define a Christian as one who has been baptized as a repenting adult. Within countries where Christianity is the historical majority religion, the term is also used by some in a casual generic sense to indicate that they are not members of nor affiliated with any other religion -

therefore considering them Christians by default. So in short, no one truly knows who or what a Christian is.

When Christians ask you to have faith, they are asking you to not think for yourself. It's your duty as a human being to ask why and how. There are so many sheep in this world that they will accept any answer they are given even if the answers make no sense at all. There is no clear definition of what a Christian is because all Christians believe in different things. A friend of mine said to me the other day something about God, and my reply to him was "I don't believe in God." His reply to me was "Why don't you believe in God?" so I asked him a few questions. I asked him, "Do you believe that dinosaurs once roamed the Earth?" He said "yes". "Do you believe that the Earth is older than 6,000 years old?" He said "yes". "Do you believe that every human on Earth is spawned from 8 Jewish people a few thousand years ago?" and he said in a very disturbed voice, "NO!" So I asked him, "Have you ever read the Bible?" and of course his response was "no".

I then told him that everything I had mentioned was in the Bible. Some people out there say things like, they didn’t have those things when the bible was written, and that is my point exactly! God is God, he knows the future, he made the universe, and he would have made the commandments with a universal language

that wasn't solely for one time period and one race of people. It would also be in a language that would be associated with anyone for all time.

11 For in six days the Lord made heaven and Earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but rested the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and consecrated it.

I could go on forever about this one. In our small little Galaxy, known as the Milky Way, we have about 300 billion stars. Each one of these stars has planets or moons around them in some form or another, so if it takes 6 whole days to make 1 little planet like ours, how long would it take to make our small little galaxy? What about the other billions and billions of galaxies we know about? He would still be making our galaxy. Does this sound like the all knowing God or a human that was 100% sure that the Earth was flat, that the sun moved around the Earth, and that the Earth was the center of the universe? 12 Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

“You shall not murder unless you go to war” is what it should say. Millions of “Christians” have murdered millions of people! Every war in the history of man is in some way connected to religion. My religion says this; your religion says that, so I'm going to kill you. That's a great philosophy to live by. (That is sarcasm for those of you who don't know.)

Deuteronomy 17:6 on the testimony of two or three witnesses a man shall be put to death, but no one shall be put to death on the testimony of only one witness.

So if 3 people get together and they don't like a person, they can make up a lie and have an innocent person put to death! Religion is so great.

Deuteronomy 17:7 the hands of the witnesses must be the first in putting him to death, and then the hands of all the people. You must purge the evil from among you.

14 You shall not commit adultery.

17 You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

God, the one and only almighty that said, "Let there be light: and there was light." (Genesis 1:3) he wrote a commandment telling us not to covet our neighbor's wife, SLAVE, ox, or donkey. I don't have a slave, ox, or donkey, and God should know that most people in this world don't have these things. 2,000 years ago when narrow minded, ignorant, bigots, wrote these commandments, I guess degrading other humans was ok. 4 Seven days from now I will send rain on the Earth for forty days and forty nights, and I will wipe from the face of the Earth every living creature I have made."

Ask yourself this question, who is the greatest mass murderer of all time? Is it Mao Ze-Dong, Joseph Stalin, or Adolf Hitler? None of the above, it's God. I don't believe this, but according to the Bible, God slaughtered babies, children, women, and every man on the planet Earth, except for the eight humans on Noah's ark. God doesn't love you, he hates you! How can God love humans when all he does throughout the whole Bible is kill us? The Bible wants us to believe that EVERY single living human on Earth, except Noah and his family, deserved to die. Unreal!

God committed Genocide on the entire human race! Every other nationality on the planet Earth was wiped from existence. Hitler and Stalin were creampuffs compared to God. You would think that a man at the age of 600 would have more than 3 children. Having 1 child every 200 years seems a little odd to me. Even if he had only one child every 10 years he would still have approximately 60 children.

7 And Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives entered the ark to escape the waters of the flood.

These are the last 8 people on all of Earth that survived the flood. That means you are spawned from a family of 8 Jewish people. All you white supremacists out there, I would seriously think twice about calling yourself a Christian in the future.

8 Pairs of clean and unclean animals, of birds and of all creatures that move along the ground,

If you have some extra time, go on the internet and look at the list of clean vs. unclean animals, it's ridiculous.

9 male and female, came to Noah and entered the ark, as God had commanded Noah.

I love how God can command every animal on the planet Earth to come to the ark with mind control and they do. Yet God didn't know that Cain had killed Able.

10 And after the seven days the floodwaters came on the Earth.

So Noah, a 600 year old man, and his family constructed a vessel in 7 days that would take a group of more than 100 men at least a couple weeks to do.

11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, on the seventeenth day of the second month—on that day all the springs

of the great deep burst forth, and the floodgates of the heavens were opened.

12 And rain fell on the Earth forty days and forty nights.

So this passage states that every square inch on the face of the Earth was covered in clouds and rained for 40 days and nights. I don't care if it rained for 40 months, it still could not have covered the entire Earth to the height of Mount Everest, this is just impossible.

13 On that very day Noah and his sons, Shem, Ham and Japheth, together with his wife and the wives of his three sons, entered the ark.

Remember these names, because we're all related to these 4 men.

14 They had with them every wild animal according to its kind, all livestock according to their kinds, every creature that moves along the ground according to its kind and every bird according to its kind, everything with wings.

No way no how all of the animals that the Bible claims went onto the arc actually did. It's 100% impossible. There is no point in debating it, because it's simply not possible.

15 Pairs of all creatures that have the breath of life in them came to Noah and entered the ark.

Can you try to imagine the amount of food it would take to feed that amount of animals? Can you try to imagine the amount of urine and feces that would have been on that ship?

16 The animals going in were male and female of every living thing, as God had commanded Noah. Then the LORD shut him in.

17 For forty days the flood kept coming on the Earth, and as the waters increased they lifted the ark high above the Earth.

18 The waters rose and increased greatly on the Earth, and the ark floated on the surface of the water.

19 They rose greatly on the Earth, and all the high mountains under the entire heavens were covered.

Right here, in plain English, it says that the water was so high it covered every mountain. The ignorant human that wrote this didn't have a clue how large the world was, and they couldn't possibly know that it is absolutely impossible to have water rise to the height of Mount Everest. There isn't enough moisture in the world to do that. Also, if there was, it would take a lot longer than 40 days and nights.

20 The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than twenty feet.

21 Every living thing that moved on the Earth perished—birds, livestock, wild animals, all the creatures that swarm over the Earth, and all mankind.

22 Everything on dry land that had the breath of life in its nostrils died.

I love how black and white this is. This is great. All too often, we hear religious people say ignorant things like, “Don’t take the Bible so literally; you must look for the meaning in every message,” or some dumb message like that. That is simply ignorant. Further, it says VERY clearly that everything on Earth died!

23 Every living thing on the face of the Earth was wiped out; men and animals and the creatures that move along the ground and the birds of the air were wiped from the Earth. Only Noah was left and those with him in the ark.

Wow, that is music to my ears. This is such a strong statement! No one in religion can debate the fact that the Bible is saying every human on Earth came from 8 Jewish people 4357 years ago.

24 The waters flooded the Earth for a hundred and fifty days.

Wow! This is too easy. How many holes are in this story? A 600 year old man and wife and his 3 sons with their wives built an ark 450 feet long, 75 feet

wide, and 45 feet high in 7 days. Not only is that not close to possible, but the size is simply not big enough to carry all of those animals.

This is also saying that every living human on the planet Earth is descended from 8 Jewish people 4,357 years ago. Further, it says that we are literally a bunch of inbred offspring created from one Jewish family! All of you Asian, African, Russian, American Indian, English, Irish, Persian, etc., people out there take heed: You all came from Noah's family 4,357 years ago. This is impossible!

It would be impossible for there to be 6 billion people on the planet Earth right now if we came from a Jewish family a few thousand years ago. We would all be the same race, and we would all be inbred! The Bible says you can't have sex with a blood relative. Noah's grandchildren had to have had sex with each other in order to produce the human race; this is what the Bible says! The thought of coming from monkeys sounds pretty good after hearing this.

The Bible says the flood happened in 2,348 B.C. in the 600th year of Noah's life. (Genesis 7:11). The year is 2009 so that means in 4,357 years, 4 couples spawned 6 billion people and that are different races. This is not possible! If Noah was 600 years old, and he only had 3 sons, they weren't really big into reproducing. You would think that Noah would have

had a few hundred children; after all, he lived to be 950 years old. None of his sons had children at the time of the arc, yet they were all married and managed to pop out 6 billion offspring. How about the scientific evidence? There is NO flood at this time or any other time this size recorded in the Earth's layers; we would still see it quite clearly. Further, the polar ice caps would have melted, and we wouldn't be able to pull core samples from 420 thousand years ago, which is common practice today. Ice core samples are similar to tree rings or sediment layers; you can determine the age by the amount of rings. We have core samples that go back 420,000 years! How could we have ice core samples this old if the world was covered in water? Water does melt ice for those who don't know that.

Leviticus 18:6-18

6 No one is to approach any close relative to have sexual relations. I am the LORD.

7 Do not dishonor your father by having sexual relations with your mother. She is your mother; do not have relations with her.

8 Do not have sexual relations with your father's wife; that would dishonor your father.

9 Do not have sexual relations with your sister, either your father's daughter or your mother's daughter, whether she was born in the same home or elsewhere.

10 Do not have sexual relations with your son's daughter or your daughter's daughter; that would dishonor you.

11 Do not have sexual relations with the daughter of your father's wife, born to your father; she is your sister.

12 Do not have sexual relations with your father's sister; she is your father's close relative.

13 Do not have sexual relations with your mother's sister, because she is your mother's close relative.

14 Do not dishonor your father's brother by approaching his wife to have sexual relations; she is your aunt.

15 Do not have sexual relations with your daughter-in-law. She is your son's wife; do not have relations with her.

16 Do not have sexual relations with your brother's wife; that would dishonor your brother.

17 Do not have sexual relations with both a woman and her daughter. Do not have sexual relations with either her son's daughter or her daughter's daughter; they are her close relatives. That is wickedness.

18 Do not take your wife's sister as a rival wife and have sexual relations with her while your wife is living.

I honestly don't know what to say about all that. The fact that this had to be written at all says to me

that this sort of thing happened quite often, and that's a scary thought.

Chapter 6

The Universe

We live in a Galaxy called the Milky Way. The Milky Way Galaxy has approximately 300 Billion stars and is 13 to 14 Billion years old. These stars have planets and moons as well (We have no idea how many planets are associated with 300 billion stars). The star in our solar system, the sun, is so massive that more than a million Earths can fit inside the sun. If we could travel in space at the speed of light (186,000 miles per second or 670,616,629 miles per hour) it would take us 100,000 light years to travel across our galaxy. According to Einstein, no physical object can travel at the speed of light, so it is unlikely that we will ever travel that fast under our current knowledge.

With human technology we can see approximately 200 billion galaxies – not stars, galaxies. Each Galaxy has approximately 200 - 300 billion stars in it (some less, some more). The Big Bang that created our universe is thought to have happened approximately 14 - 15 billion years ago. The Earth and our solar system is approximately 4.6 Billion years old, life started forming approximately 3.5 Billion years ago, and 570 million years ago there was an explosion of life on Earth. Dinosaurs roamed the Earth for 185 million years, and man has been around for approximately 4 million years. Everything I just said is fact, yet it is a 100% contradiction to the Bible. Both of these things can't be true, either what I just said is true, or the Bible is true.

80 years ago we believed that our entire universe was the size of our own miniscule galaxy. Imagine what we will learn in another 80 years. Trying to comprehend the size of the universe is almost impossible. Counting that many objects is almost impossible. Take some time and count out loud to 10,000, then to 100,000 then to 1,000,000 then to 100 billion. How long do you think it would take you to count to 100 billion? How long do you think it would take you to search each one of those trillions of planets for life across all the hundreds of billions of galaxies? It is literally impossible to comprehend something that immense; yet according to most religions, were all alone in the universe.

Imagine this: take a grain of sand and put it in a fish bowl the size of a basketball. That 1 grain of sand represents our entire galaxy with 300 billion stars. Now fill the rest of the fish bowl with sand. That fishbowl with sand represents our currently known universe. Set the filled fishbowl on the ground. Take another fish bowl and fill it with sand and set it on the ground 5 feet away. These 5 feet of space represents 20 billion light years between the 2 universes. Now, imagine that duplicated as many times as it takes to cover the Earth with fishbowls filled with sand and all the space throughout the center of Earth. Think of that on an infinite scale. Duplicate that all the way to the size of our own Galaxy, or the known universe. This may be an actual reality, we just don't know. It's very difficult for anyone to try to imagine infinite space.

Try for a minute to comprehend the enormity of our known universe; it's very difficult. A good way to imagine the size of the Milky Way Galaxy is this. If our solar system is as large as a music CD, the Galaxy would be as large as the Earth. As far as we know there are a trillion universes out there. The space that we see between galaxies can be duplicated between universes but on a much larger scale. Our known universe may be just another group of super galaxies, and in turn, our group of hundreds of billions of galaxies can be copied for an infinite amount of time.

Our universe was created by what we know as The Big Bang. There could be an infinite number of universes out there. What I'm saying is this: 14 billion years ago there could have been a mega explosion (The Big Bang), and that is what created our known universe. It is possible, in fact, that this may be happening on a daily basis. These universes are so far away that we literally cannot see them because light only travels so fast, and the Universe has only been around for 14 Billion years.

The speed of light is limited, and it might take light 20 billion years to get to us from the closest universe. There is no name for this theory; I just think this may be a reality. We don't even know what dark matter is, or how the galaxy doesn't spin apart. It may be magnetism for all we know. They say it's gravity from dark matter, but who really knows? We don't know what dark matter is. We don't even know what light is; we see it, but do not really know what it is. Dark matter may be collapsed galaxies that turned into super massive black holes and the reason we cannot see dark matter is because light can't escape. All the matter from 300 billion stars would be condensed into a black super dense orb the size of our Earth. Again, we just don't know at this point.

The reason it's important to understand the amount of information that we don't know is to show you that it's okay not to know, and it's okay not to

believe a group of people from 2,000 years ago that knew far less than what we know today. 2,000 years ago everyone knew 100% without a doubt that the Earth was flat, that the Earth was the center of the universe, and that there was no such thing as germs. Obviously, we know today that these things are not true, and that they were wrong.

Chapter 7

Jesus vs. Buddha

Predestination says that going to heaven was predetermined at birth, so the thinking is; I'm already going to hell or heaven so I may as well do what I want.

This is a recipe for anarchy. This is very interesting to me because in my opinion this is the exact reason religion was created. Before religion there was anarchy and no reason to be good; no one had the fear of God. People could do what they wanted without any fear of repercussion. Someone then came up with the idea that there needs to be some sort of law to keep people under control. The fear of going to hell is reason enough for most Christians to be mindful of doing the right thing.

Every religion on the planet Earth knows without a doubt that it is the correct religion. There are

approximately 10,000 to 50,000 different religions on the planet Earth; depending on whom you ask; some of the major religions are listed here.

So here is the problem: How can all religions be right? Answer: They can't! If one religion is wrong,

then all religions are wrong. In addition, how can there be more than one Christian religion? If Christianity is right at all, there would be only one type of Christianity, not 30,000 different distinct Christian religions. For thousands of years Christians have been trying to prove that Jesus was the son of God and that God does exist. If this were true, they wouldn't have to prove anything. The fact that there are some many different religions proves it without a doubt.

If someone is a Christian, they feel their religion is correct and every other religion is wrong. When they meet a Jewish person, or any other non-Christian, they automatically judge them and know that, upon death, they will burn in hell for all eternity. All of this is true simply because the Jewish person doesn't believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God. It doesn't matter that Christianity came from the Jewish religion, it doesn't matter that Jesus Christ was Jewish, all that matters is the Jewish person doesn't believe Jesus is the son of God.

Use common sense for one second and think about how crazy that is. How is it possible for any religion to be right, if all religions are different? Only one religion can be right if any religions are right at all. We have 50,000 or so to choose from, what if they are all wrong and science is right? How do we decide what to believe? How do we decide what is right and what is wrong? How about common sense? If you can see it,

touch it, and smell it, more than likely, it's what it seems. That being said, I know the Grand Canyon and humans are more than 6,000 years old. I know that it's impossible for 6 billion people with different nationalities to come from Noah's family, I know the Earth is not the center of the universe, and I know dinosaurs once roamed the Earth.

All of these things are contradictory to the Bible, so using common sense, I would say the Bible is wrong. Some of the messages in the Bible are good – not killing, do unto others as you would have them do unto you, etc. I'm saying Adam and Eve, Noah's Ark, etc., are simply stories, and not very good at that. There are 5th graders who can write a better story than most of those in the Bible. The Bible is twofaced. It says one thing on the surface, but deep down, the horrible truth of religion and the Bible rear their ugly heads.

Christians say that Buddhism is wrong and Christianity is right, Christians say that about *every other religion* as well. Buddhism is a very interesting religion. It's actually not a religion in the normal tradition of religions. Buddhists believe in themselves and bettering themselves through internal strength, whereas most other religions need to turn to false Gods to better themselves. Buddhist's have never started a war and have never killed millions of people like Christians, yet they both have the same rule of not

killing. Christians are twofaced hypocrites that say one thing, but do another. Buddhists have a basic code of ethics that consists of the following tenets:

1. Refrain from killing living things.
2. Refrain from stealing.
3. Refrain from un-chastity (sensuality, sexuality, lust).
4. Refrain from lying.
5. Refrain from taking intoxicants.
6. Refrain from taking food at inappropriate times (only from sunrise till noon).
7. Refrain from singing, dancing, playing music or attending entertainment programs (performances).
8. Refrain from wearing perfume, cosmetics and garland (decorative accessories).
9. Refrain from sitting on high chairs and sleeping on luxurious, soft beds.
10. Refrain from accepting money.

Buddhism goes beyond religion and is more of a philosophy or ‘way of life’. It is a philosophy because

philosophy means 'love of wisdom' and the Buddhist path can be summed up as:

1. To lead a moral life,
2. To be mindful and aware of thoughts and actions, and
3. To develop wisdom and understanding.

According to buddhanet.net Buddhists don't believe in God. There are several reasons for this. The Buddha, like modern sociologists and psychologists, believed that religious ideas, and especially the God idea, have their origin in fear. The Buddha says:

"Gripped by fear men go to the sacred mountains, sacred groves, sacred trees and shrines".

Primitive man found himself in a dangerous and hostile world, the fear of wild animals, of not being able to find enough food, of injury or disease, and of natural phenomena like thunder, lightning and volcanoes. These were constantly with him. Finding no security, he created the idea of Gods in order to give him comfort in good times, courage in times of danger, and consolation when things went wrong. To this day, you will notice that people become more religious at times of crises, you will hear them say that the belief in a God or Gods gives them the strength they need to deal with life. You will hear them explain that they believe in a particular God because they

prayed in time of need and their prayer was answered. All this seems to support the Buddha's teaching that the God-idea is a response to fear and frustration. The Buddha taught us to try to understand our fears, to lessen our desires and to calmly and courageously accept the things we cannot change. He replaced fear, not with irrational belief but with rational understanding.

(Wow! That is so dead-on accurate, it's scary)

The second reason the Buddha did not believe in a God is because there does not seem to be any evidence to support this idea. There are numerous religions, all claiming that they alone have God's words preserved in their holy book, that they alone understand God's nature, that their God exists, and that the Gods of other religions do not. Some claim that God is masculine, and some that She is feminine, and others that It is neuter. They are all satisfied that there is ample evidence to prove the existence of their God, but they laugh in disbelief at the evidence that other religions use to prove the existence of a different God. It is not surprising that, with so many different religions spending so many centuries trying to prove the existence of their Gods, there is still no real, concrete, substantial or irrefutable evidence that has been found. Buddhists suspend judgment until such evidence is forthcoming.

The third reason the Buddha did not believe in a God is that the belief is not necessary. Some claim that the belief in a God is necessary in order to explain the origin of the universe. But this is not so. Science has very convincingly explained how the universe came into being without having to introduce the God-idea. Some claim that a belief in God is necessary to have a happy, meaningful life. Again, we can see that this is not so. There are millions of atheists and free-thinkers, not to mention many Buddhists, who live useful, happy and meaningful lives without belief in a God.

Some claim that belief in God's power is necessary because humans, being weak, do not have the strength to help themselves. Once again, the evidence indicates the opposite. One often hears of people who have overcome great disabilities and handicaps and enormous odds and difficulties through their own inner resources, through their own efforts, and without belief in a God. Some claim that God is necessary in order to give man salvation. But this argument only works if you accept the theological concept of salvation, and Buddhists do not accept such a concept. Based on his own experience, the Buddha saw that each human being had the capacity to purify the mind, develop infinite love and compassion and perfect understanding. He shifted attention from the heavens to the heart and encouraged us to find solutions to our problems through self-understanding.

Everything about the Buddhist beliefs I agree with. The only things I don't agree with are

6. Refrain from taking food at inappropriate times (only from sunrise till noon).

Every bodybuilder on planet Earth knows that you should eat every 3 hours; I'm guessing most Buddhist's are bodybuilders.

7. Refrain from singing, dancing, playing music or attending entertainment programs (performances).

I can't see how this could be a bad thing. I think enjoying life is the most important thing you can do in life.

8. Refrain from wearing perfume, cosmetics and garland (decorative accessories).

I'm guessing when they made these rules things were much different in the world than they are today.

9. Refrain from sitting on high chairs and sleeping on luxurious, soft beds.

This makes no sense to me, if you don't sleep on a good mattress you'll get a bad back and you don't get a good night's sleep.

10. Refrain from accepting money.

Chapter 8

Chapter 9

The Creation of Earth

G*enesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the Earth.*

According to biblical work by Archbishop James Ussher, the Earth was created on the evening of October 22, 4004 BC which makes the Earth about 6013 years old.

2 Now the Earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

This is called the sun, the center of our solar system.

4 God saw that the light was good, and He separated the light from the darkness.

A man wrote this a couple thousand year ago, because he thought the Earth was flat. He didn't know that the Earth was actually round and that day and night happen simply because the Earth spins.

5 God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.

God knew the Earth was round and would have told Adam and Eve the truth about Earth being a planet.

6 And God said, "Let there be an expanse between the waters to separate water from water."

7 So God made the expanse and separated the water under the expanse from the water above it. And it was so.

8 God called the expanse "sky." And there was evening, and there was morning—the second day.

It took God two days to create land and sky, but one second to create the sun, which is a million times the size of Earth. Yeah, okay, that makes perfect sense.

9 And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear." And it was so.

This simply did not happen, a human wrote this. We know that because there are plenty of continents on our Earth, and there were there 6,000 years ago as well. Narrow-minded humans wrote this at that time humans didn't know that there was more to the Earth than where they were standing. If God did this, he would have informed everyone that they weren't on the only piece of land on the Earth.

10 God called the dry ground "land," and the gathered waters he called "seas." And God saw that it was good.

11 Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds." And it was so.

12 The land produced vegetation: plants bearing seed according to their kinds and trees bearing fruit with seed in it according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good.

This is called photosynthesis, and it has been happening on the planet Earth for millions of years. Coal, a material we burn that pollutes the ozone layer, is simply plants that have been fossilized for millions of years. We could not have fossilized plant life on Earth if the Earth was only 6,000 years old.

13 And there was evening, and there was morning—the third day.

14 And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark seasons and days and years,

15 and let them be lights in the expanse of the sky to give light on the Earth." And it was so.

These are called stars, and there are 300 billion of them in our Milky Way galaxy alone. I find it interesting that God took six days to create our little planet, but it only took one second for Him to create the billions of galaxies out there with all the hundreds of billions of stars in each one. That's a good trick.

16 God made two great lights—the greater light to govern the day and the lesser light to govern the night. He also made the stars.

That's called the sun and the moon.

17 God set them in the expanse of the sky to give light on the Earth,

18 to govern the day and the night, and to separate light from darkness. And God saw that it was good.

God wouldn't need to see that it was good or bad, he's God, he would know ahead of time if it was good or bad.

19 And there was evening, and there was morning—the fourth day.

20 And God said, "Let the water teem with living creatures, and let birds fly above the Earth across the expanse of the sky."

21 So God created the great creatures of the sea and every living and moving thing with which the water teems, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

What about the dinosaurs?

22 God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the Earth."

23 And there was evening, and there was morning—the fifth day.

24 And God said, "Let the land produce living creatures according to their kinds: livestock, creatures that move along the ground, and wild animals, each according to its kind." And it was so.

25 God made the wild animals according to their kinds, the livestock according to their kinds, and all the creatures that move along the ground according to their kinds. And God saw that it was good.

This is fairy tale, and not a very good one. Charles Darwin was much more intelligent than the person who wrote this.

26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the Earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground."

This is mans own superiority complex, do you see how man is supposed to rule over everything?

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

Again, man and his superiority complex, man created God in his own image, not the other way around. God did not create man, man created God.

28 God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the Earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

29 Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole Earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food.

30 And to all the beasts of the Earth and all the birds of the air and all the creatures that move on the ground—everything that has the breath of life in it—I give every green plant for food." And it was so.

31 God saw all that he had made, and it was very good. And there was evening, and there was morning—the sixth day.

If God saw that this was good, and in turn, made all these wonderful things, why did he destroy them with a flood? Why wouldn't he just kill all the evil people on the planet and leave all the animals and plants alone? Am I the only person on Earth that thinks about these things?

Genesis 2

1 Thus the heavens and the Earth were completed in all their vast array.

2 By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work.

God, the almighty that created everything in the universe got tired? Are you kidding me right now? He's God! It's not like he was a boxer that just got done fighting fifteen rounds, he used his power to

create these things. Again, a 5th grader could have written a better story than this.

3 And God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done.

The Bible says that this happened 6,000 years ago. Excavations at Tel Ramad on the outskirts of the city have demonstrated that Damascus was inhabited as early as 8,000 to 10,000 BC. Archaeologists have unearthed the remains of over 20 successive settlements in Jericho, the first of which dates back to 11,000 years ago (9,000 BCE). If the story from the bible is true, and the Earth was created 6,000 years ago, how can these cities have existed?

Chapter 10

Adam and Eve

G*enesis 2:4 This is the account of the heavens and the Earth when they were created. When the LORD God made the Earth and the heavens- 5 and no shrub of the field had yet appeared on the Earth and no plant of the field had yet sprung up, for the LORD God had not sent rain on the Earth and there was no man to work the ground,*

This is called photosynthesis and has been going on for millions of years. It doesn't take a man or woman to work the ground to maintain plant life. Take the Amazon jungle for example, no one is working the ground there, and plant life grows just fine there, in fact, abundantly.

Photosynthesis is the conversion of light energy into chemical energy by living organisms. The raw

materials are carbon dioxide and water, the energy source is sunlight, and the end-products include glucose and oxygen. Nearly all of life depends on it. It is a complex process occurring in higher plants, phytoplankton, algae, and even bacteria.

6 but streams came up from the Earth and watered the whole surface of the ground-

7 the LORD God formed the man The Hebrew for man (adam) sounds like and may be related to the Hebrew for ground (adamah) it is also the name Adam (see Gen. 2:20). From the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

Here's what I don't understand. I always hear Christians bitching and whining about how there is NO WAY we came from apes, (even though we have abundant scientific proof) – but the alternative that Christian's want you to believe is that men came from dirt, and that woman came from the rib of the dirt man. Yeah, that's much better.

8 Now the LORD God had planted a garden in the east, in Eden; and there he put the man he had formed.

Why would God create millions of plants and animals, but then only create one man and one woman? Why not create 1,000 men and 1,000 women? Then God make rules about incest knowing full well the only way Adam can Eve can populate the Earth is

for their children to have sex with each other, and their grandchildren to have sex with each other. The guy who wrote this story wasn't really a big thinker.

9 And the LORD God made all kinds of trees grow out of the ground—trees that were pleasing to the eye and good for food. In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

What is the tree of knowledge of good and evil? How does a tree have knowledge of good and evil? At this stage of the game, there was no such thing as evil, there was only good.

10 A river watering the garden flowed from Eden; from there it was separated into four headwaters.

11 The name of the first is the Pishon; it winds through the entire land of Havilah, where there is gold.

12 (The gold of that land is good; aromatic resin and onyx are also there.)

13 The name of the second river is the Gihon; it winds through the entire land of Cush.

14 The name of the third river is the Tigris; it runs along the east side of Asshur. And the fourth river is the Euphrates.

15 The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

16 And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden;

17 but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."

God is lying to Adam when he says this to him. Does this compute to religious people out there? God lied to Adam. Doesn't one of the 10 Commandments say: "You shall not lie." (*You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.*)

18 The LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him."

Make him a helper? Wow, women sure have come a long way! This is disgraceful and something only a Jewish man from 2,000 years ago would say, not the Creator of the Universe. It would be really cool if all women thought they were put on Earth to be man's helpers. Then I could sit at home all day and spend her money. If I were a woman, this would infuriate me. If I were a woman, this alone would make me not listen to anything the bible has to say.

19 Now the LORD God had formed out of the ground all the beasts of the field and all the birds of the air. He brought them to the man to see what he would name them; and whatever the man called each living creature, that was its name.

20 So the man gave names to all the livestock, the birds of the air and all the beasts of the field. But for Adam no suitable helper was found.

So God gave Adam the ability to talk and name all the animals, but he didn't think to create more than one man or woman.

21 So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the man's ribs and closed up the place with flesh.

What sense does this make? He's God; he just created man from dust and created the universe with the snap of his fingers, why does he need the rib of a man? The truth is that a Jewish guy that hates women wanted to make sure all women knew for all of eternity that they were inferior to man, and thus, men could feel superior to women.

22 Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man.

If I were a woman this would be the second reason I would never listen to anything from the bible. If this doesn't prove that an egotistical man wrote the bible purely from fiction, I don't know what does.

23 The man said, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called 'woman, for she was taken out of man."

Christians think that this is a better explanation than millions of years of evolution.

24 For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.

What mother and father? They were made from dust and a rib. There are 2 people on the planet Earth right now, and they don't have children.

25 The man and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.

Why would they feel shame? They are the first two humans on the planet Earth, and they don't even know what clothing is because it hadn't been invented yet. DUH! Again, only a man would think like this.

Genesis 3:

The Fall of Man

1 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"

A talking snake, are you kidding me? Also, God didn't say this to Eve, God said it to Adam.

2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden,

3 but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.' "

If I believed in God, this would seriously upset me. This says that God lied to Adam and Eve. Thus, God lied to the first two humans on Earth, on the first day of their creation. This is just sad.

4 "You will not surely die," the serpent said to the woman.

So the Devil is telling Eve the truth, and God lied to Adam about the apple. Am I missing something here?

5 "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

Why were her eyes closed at this point in time? Closed to what? There is no such thing as good or evil with Adam and Eve, they are the first humans on the planet. The only evil will be when their son kills their other son and their children have sex with each other to populate the Earth.

6 When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it.

“The woman,” Can’t they even say her name! The men that wrote the bible hated women so much that they couldn’t even say her name. So a woman created sin and ruined men for all eternity. When did they get married? The bible talks about some of the dumbest things imaginable, but it skips the part about the first two humans on Earth getting married. This is the third reason women should veto the Bible.

7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.

This says that being naked is a bad thing. How is being naked a bad thing? They are the only two people on Earth at that time. If my wife and I were the only two people on Earth, I would probably walk around naked all the time.

8 Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

9 But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"

He’s God. He’s all knowing. I think he would know where they were. Here’s a question for all the Christians: For years and years God just hung out with the humans on Earth; it talks about this throughout

the bible. So if God is so friendly with humans, why is he not walking among us today?

10 He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid."

How can Adam be naked? He just covered himself with a fig leaf; I wish they would get this story straight.

11 And he said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?"

God did not command Adam to not eat from the tree. He didn't say "I command you not to eat from the tree" God lied and told Adam that he would die if he ate from the tree.

12 The man said, "The woman you put here with me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it."

Good job Adam, blame it on the woman. Now I know why I always blame my wife when I can't find something. That's where I get it from; blame it on the woman.

13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

So man blames woman, woman blames snake,
God punishes all.

14 So the LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this "Cursed are you above all the livestock and all the wild animals! You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life.

This is what God does in his spare time? He has arguments with talking snakes? Doesn't this seem beneath God? Don't you think he would have better things to do? A snake doesn't crawl, it slithers. I think God would know the difference. I think God could have come up with a better use of his time. He could have come down from heaven and had a chat with Hitler for instance; I think that would have been a better use of his time. God will punish Adam and Eve for eating an apple, but he won't punish Hitler for killing 50 million people.

15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."

God put a feeling of hatred between Eve and the snake? And Eve's children will stomp the heads of the children of the snake and the snake babies will strike at the heels of the children. This is pretty much the dumbest thing I've ever heard.

16 To the woman he said, "I will greatly increase your pains in childbearing; with pain you will give birth to children. Your desire will be for your husband, and he will rule over you."

This is pretty horrible, God is telling Eve that she is basically the scum of the Earth, and further, that the only reason she's on the planet is to be ruled by man. How can a self-respecting woman read this and continue to call herself Christian. This is just sad. If Christian women listened to this and followed this, there would be no infidelity or divorce by women, and we all know that isn't the case. Also, it doesn't take a rocket scientist to figure out that if you try to push something the size of a honeydew out of something the size of a golf ball, it's going to hurt.

17 To Adam he said, "Because you listened to your wife and ate from the tree about which I commanded you, 'You must not eat of it,' "Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat of it all the days of your life.

What? This is so ignorant that I can't even try to make sense of it.

18 It will produce thorns and thistles for you, and you will eat the plants of the field.

19 By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground, since from it you were taken; for dust you are and to dust you will return."

This sounds like a father disciplining his child. I hate to break it to all you bible thumpers out there, but everything in the universe is made of atoms, not dust. Also, carbon is present in all known life forms, including apes and humans.

20 Adam named his wife Eve, because she would become the mother of all the living.

Is this more proof that we are all inbred? So the entire population was inbred, then they all died because of the flood, and then we were all inbred again from Noah's family. Evolution is sounding better and better every second.

21 The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.

So now God is a seamstress? He's making clothes for Adam and Eve out of skin? So God killed animals that he created? He killed them, skinned them and then made clothes for Adam and Eve. This story just keeps getting better and better.

22 And the LORD God said, "The man has now become like one of us, knowing good and evil. He must not be allowed to reach out his hand and take also from the tree of life and eat, and live forever."

Who is "One of us" referring to? Who was God talking to? He's God, and there is only one God, so

who is God speaking of when he says, “The man has now become like one of us?” It’s my understanding that there is only one God.

23 So the LORD God banished him from the Garden of Eden to work the ground from which he had been taken.

24 After he drove the man out, he placed on the east side of the Garden of Eden cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life.

I don’t even want to try to figure out what this is trying to say. This is a fairy tale and not a very good one at that.
